Why Japan?

Japan is set to become one of the key markets for offshore wind developments in the Asia Pacific region, with a projected 10GW of operational capacity by 2030. Leading global developers in the offshore wind sector, including Ørsted and E.ON, have recently announced partnerships with local operators for the joint development of offshore wind projects. Our own scoping of the market has indicated that while developers in Japan are waiting for certainty on regulation, the market is eager to learn about the requirements needed to successfully deliver projects. The UK supply chain has an opportunity to embark upon early engagement (much like our European counterparts in the German, Dutch and Danish supply chain are doing).

"The winds of change continue to blow for Japan's energy mix. And the future of offshore wind looks bright. We want UK capabilities to be showcased here for companies to take early mover advantage and start building strategic relationships with the industry locally.
