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Market Intelligence

South Korea's energy market is set to experience growth in the coming years to support the domestic and global demand. The downstream sector is expected to dominate the country's oil and gas market as it aims to cope with future demand for refined products such as gasoline and diesel in the transportation sector, as well as the demand for other petroleum derivatives such as ethylene mainly for the production of chemical products and polymers. The nation also intends to increase the export of chemicals and polymers to other nations globally.

South Korea is also looking to LNG to decarbonise its energy industry. Under the South Korea's Basic Plan for Power Supply 2020-34, South Korea aims to increase the capacity of LNG to Power plants to 59.1GW by 2034. The midstream sector is currently worth around US\$2.2bn and LNG import is expected to further increase in the coming years and drive the midstream sector in the country forward.

In addition to the thriving Oil & Gas sectors, South Korea aims to develop cleaner energy generation to reduce its carbon emissions. Under South Korea's Renewable Electricity 3020 (RE3020) Implementation Plan, the country aims to aggressively boost its green energy power generation goals to 20% by 2030 and 30% to 35% by 2040. The country plans to construct 13GW of offshore wind, including 4.6GW of floating wind power by 2030.

In February 2021, the South Korean government announced plans to construct the world's largest wind power plant with a capacity of 8.2GW in Sinan region, with full operation anticipated by 2030. The country will rank sixth globally in offshore wind capacity by 2030 if all phases of the government-led project are completed as planned. On the hydrogen side, under its Hydrogen Economy Roadmap, South Korea aims to supply 15 GW of fuel cells for utility-scale power generation and 2.1GW of commercial and residential fuel cells by 2040. South Korea's hydrogen industry is expected to almost double in size from US\$10.5bn in 2020 to US\$20bn by 2030. In addition to that, the announcement of Korea's Green New Deal in July 2020 - a coronavirus stimulus plan outlining US\$54bn with US\$15bn to be used for green mobility, particularly hydrogen projects by 2025 - will without a doubt set the country on its way to achieving its aggressive long-term hydrogen goals.
