



HOW TO ВООК







Malaysia stands as a strategic hub in Southeast Asia, with a well-established and continually evolving oil and gas industry. Given Malaysia strategic location and dynamic energy landscape, the country drives the region's oil and gas development and continues to attract global interest. In February 2025, Malaysia has launched Malaysia Bid Round 2025 (MBR 2025) which has captured the interest of leading international oil and gas companies.

Across the region, the APAC oil and gas market continues to advance with the sector investments projected to see \$899 billion. Licensing rounds scheduled for 2025 and 2026 in countries such as Malaysia, Indonesia and Brunei are expected to drive further exploration activities, which will feed into future field development projects. Growth in demand for natural gas is actively driving midstream infrastructure development across the region. Governments are responding to support future gas demand, driven by rising electricity needs from the rapid expansion of data centres and ensuring stable electricity supply.

Alongside this thriving oil and gas industry, the offshore wind sector is gaining momentum with projected additional capacity of around 100 GW by 2035. Key markets include China, South Korea, Taiwan, Vietnam and Japan. Notably, Australia, while still emerging, is expected to have one of the largest offshore wind pipelines in the long term. Whilst the ambitions are growing in the region, large scale additions will not be seen until post 2030.

National hydrogen strategies are in place in countries within the APAC region that include India, Japan, Australia, China, South Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, and New Zealand, with each countries aiming to adopt hydrogen as driving force behind their energy transition effort. As regulatory frameworks evolve, APAC is emerging as a key market for carbon capture, led by Australia and joined by growing efforts in Indonesia, Malaysia, and China. Given the region's reliance on coal-fired power, carbon capture is anticipated to play a critical role in supporting decarbonisation strategies across APAC.


