MARKET INTELLIGENCE



Malaysia's strategic location and dynamic energy landscape position the country as a key driver of regional oil and gas development while continuing to attract strong global interest. According to PETRONAS' 2026–2028 outlook, the company aims to sustain domestic production at approximately 2 million boe/d through 2028. In February 2025, Malaysia launched the Malaysia Bid Round 2025 and 2026 (MBR 2025/26), which have drawn significant interest from leading international oil and gas companies. In parallel, growing demand for natural gas is driving the expansion of midstream infrastructure across the region. Governments are responding proactively to support future gas demand largely fuelled by rising electricity consumption from the rapid expansion of data centres and the need to ensure a stable power supply.

Carbon Capture sector is also experiencing notable growth in Malaysia. In March 2025, the Malaysian Parliament passed the Carbon Capture, Utilisation and Storage (CCUS) Act 2025 establishing a comprehensive legal framework for the regulation, licensing and management of CCUS activities. This development reinforces Malaysia's ambition to position itself as a regional CCUS hub. In addition, the country is strategically leveraging its abundant natural resources particularly hydropower to advance its ambitions of becoming a regional hydrogen hub guided by the National Energy Transition Roadmap (NETR). These intensified efforts demonstrate Malaysia's firm commitment to achieving its national target of net zero emissions by 2050.

Across the wider region, EICDataStream tracks more than 3,884 projects across all sectors with an estimated total CAPEX of US\$2.84 trillion. Mature renewables and energy transition projects account for 62% of this pipeline indicating a clear regional pivot towards cleaner energy. Nevertheless, the oil and gas sector continues to represent the largest share of investment accounting for 33% of total projected CAPEX equivalent to approximately US\$874 billion.
