Market Intelligence

The energy sector in the Middle East remains highly dynamic, shaped by a range of ongoing developments. There is an increasing focus across the region on expanding renewable energy sources as nations aim to broaden their energy portfolios, strengthen energy independence, and curb greenhouse gas emissions. Solar power, in particular, has experienced notable expansion, with countries including Saudi Arabia, Iraq, Kuwait, and the UAE channelling investments into major solar infrastructure. The projected capital expenditure (CAPEX) for energy-related initiatives across all sectors in the Middle East from 2025 to 2030 stands at an estimated \$1,144 billion.

Middle Eastern governments are placing growing importance on energy transition strategies to meet international climate targets and reduce environmental impact. These efforts include capital allocation toward renewables, improved energy efficiency, and the deployment of cleaner technologies such as carbon capture and storage (CCS). Approximately 8.46% of the region's total estimated CAPEX for energy initiatives is attributed to energy transition projects.

In summary, the Middle East's energy industry is undergoing continuous transformation, shaped by global influences, regional shifts, and emerging technologies. While traditional hydrocarbons remain central to the region's economy, there is a growing recognition of the importance of sustainable energy development and the need to transition towards a more diversified and resilient energy future.


