Why AOG?

- AOG is the largest oil & gas event in Australia. It's the event where the supply chain meets the Operators and their contractors
- New to AOG 2020 is the Oil & Gas Industry Operator Supplier Forum with support from key Australian operators

The world's second largest exporter of LNG, Australia has total proved reserves of 128 trillion cubic feet of gas and a requirement for more. Several \$billion of capital expenditure is required to bring the sizeable gas resource on the north west coast into production and we see several developments make progress. Woodside Petroleum are leading the way with the plans to develop the Scarborough Gas Field and Browse Upstream fields which holds 15.4 Tcf of dry gas and 453 MMboe of condensate.

Associated with the offshore discoveries is the requirement for new LNG infrastructure with a new 4-5 mtpa train set to reach FID in 2020. Major players including ConocoPhillips, Chevron and Shell are also progressing with some major offshore developments and these will offer opportunities to supply chain companies that supply goods and services to the subsea, FPSO and LNG markets.
