Market Intelligence

The release of the EU Net Zero Strategy in 2020 placed hydrogen at the core of its decarbonisation strategy. This was complimented by the RePowerEU in 2022 which targets 10 million tonnes per year of hydrogen production by 2030, with a further 10 million tonnes to be imported. Further to this the EU mandated 42.5% of hydrogen produced by 2030 to be derived from renewables. Several countries including Spain, Portugal and Germany have updated their strategies to increase their targets for hydrogen production. The European Commission's second European Hydrogen Bank auction, in May, saw 15 projects awarded a total of €992m in the form of subsidies which will be given over a 10-year period. Three large-scale projects from both the first and second auctions have recently pulled out of receiving the subsidies, due to delays in project development, strict timelines and incomplete infrastructure , leaving a question mark over the credibility of the funding scheme.

According to EICDatastream there are currently 490 hydrogen projects, including green, blue, storage and pipelines, in various stages of development set to come online by 2030, with an estimated CAPEX value of USD\$251 billion. The majority of these projects are green, accounting for 83% with a combined capacity of 67.9GW. The UK (112, ~5.5GW) leads in the way in term of the number of green hydrogen projects followed by Germany (58 projects, ~9.7GW) and Spain (48 projects, ~14GW). The German Government is aiming to be a regional leader, targeting at least 10GW of production capacity by 2030, alongside this, heightened ambitions for imports have been designated to the with up to 70% of demand expected to be met through imports. Developments are underway with the green light being given to the €20 billion Hydrogen Core Network being developed by FNB Gas, this aims to form the nationwide backbone of Germany's hydrogen sector connecting the many hydrogen sites targeting industrial sites across Germany. Further to this, Germany is investing in numerous cross-border projects to create 'hydrogen corridors' connecting hydrogen production in Northern Africa to industries in Germany and other central Eastern European nations that will integrate hydrogen pipelines into these networks.


