WHY ALGERIA?

Algeria is the largest natural gas producer in Africa, and is among the top three oil producers within the continent. Proven natural gas reserves and crude oil reserves are estimated at 4,504 billion cubic metres and 12,200 million barrels. The oil and gas industry plays a key role in the Algerian economy, with revenues generated from the sector accounting for approximately 30% of the country's GDP, more than 95% of export earnings, and 60% of budget revenues.

The oil and gas industry is dominated by Sonatrach who are proposing to make investments of approximately \$55 billion between 2017 and 2022. 29% of this investment is expected to be seen in the upstream sector, 30% in the downstream and 41% in the midstream. (Source: EICDataStream)

During the last 12 months several significant contracts have been awarded to major international contractors including L&T Hydrocarbon Engineering, Emerson, Fores Engineering, Cosider Group and KBR.

The delegation will give companies the opportunity to meet with the major investors and contractors in the market and to get a better understanding of the huge opportunities that exist for the UK supply chain to supply goods and services.
