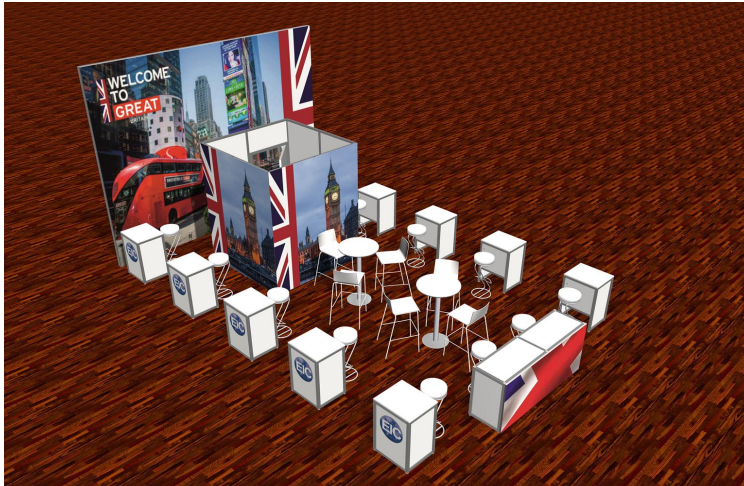

The cost of decommissioning and waste disposal is estimated to be at least £50 billion. The scale of work ahead means that decommissioning is set to last into the second half of this century.

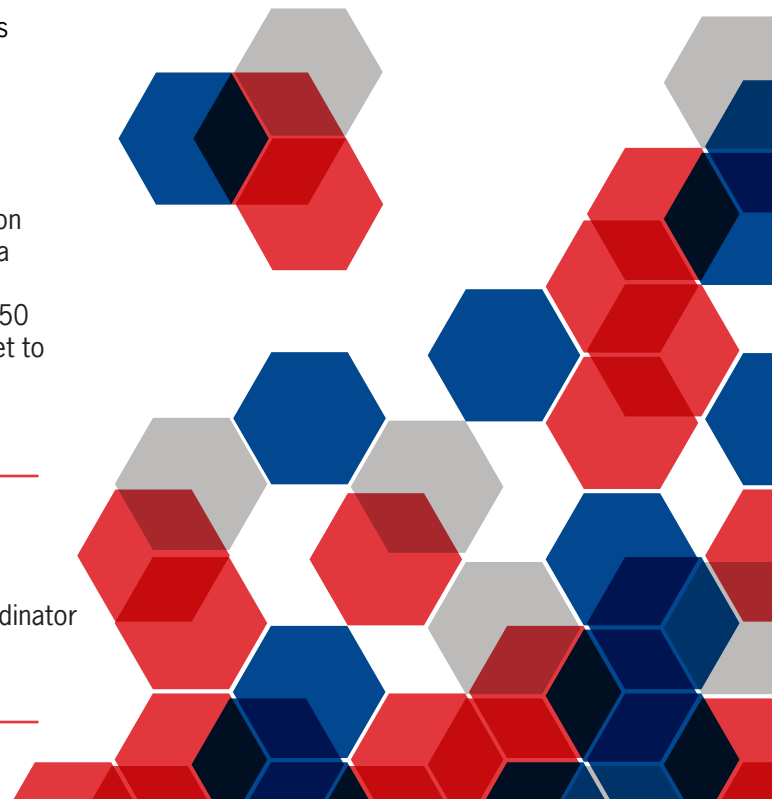
