Germany's decision to phase out nuclear power following the incident at the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant in Japan in March 2011, marks the beginning of the end to five decades of nuclear power generation in the country. Germany is now set to embark upon a programme to decommission its 17 nuclear power plants, with 9 plants already shut down since 2011, and a further 8 to be closed gradually by the end of 2022.

The cost of the decommissioning and waste disposal programme is estimated to be at least £50 billion, with the scale of work ahead meaning that decommissioning the 17 nuclear power plants across the country is set to last into the second half of this century.
