SPACE

The cost of space is £410/sqm.

FACILITIES CHARGE INCL. SHELL SCHEME

In addition to walls, carpeting and company/UK identification the shell scheme package will also provide power, lighting, display aids and furniture.


CORNER FEE

WHY EXHIBIT AT OGA 2017

Malaysia has an estimated proven reserve of 4 billion barrels of oil and approximately 83 trillion cubic feet of natural gas, while it produces approximately 597,500 barrels a day of oil products. Malaysia is the second largest Oil & Gas producer in Southeast Asia, and the second largest exporter of natural gas in the world, after Qatar.

In the context of its domestic upstream activities which spans 101 Production Sharing Contracts (PSCs) and 6 Risk Sharing Contracts (RSCs), opportunity awaits to unlock reserves from these untapped fields. Under the RSCs, Malaysia envisions to unlock an estimated 0.6 billion boe spread across over 100 marginal fields, while the under-explored deep-water has a potential reserve of 7 billion boe, and 14 identified oilfields where Enhances Oil Recovery (EOR) has a potential 0.8 to 1 billion boe is compelling.

Malaysia has positioned itself strongly to support the needs of the oil & gas value chain domestically and regionally. This is largely in line with the country's aspirations to become a regional Oil & Gas hub.
